**GOAL I: The Ozark R-VI School District will monitor and analyze instruction through assessments and observations to measure alignment to adopted curricular standards. (District 1.A.5)**

**Objective 1.1**

The district will implement adopted curricular standards within every classroom.

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| Strategy 1.1.1 | During the 2016 – 17 and 2017 – 18 school years, the curriculum committee will recommend standards to the Ozark Board of Education to adopt. |
| Strategy 1.1.2 | Curriculum documents will be written, revised, and/or aligned to the new Missouri Learning Standards.  |

**Measurement:**

1. The BOE will receive an annual update on student achievement
2. Administrators will audit the use of written curriculum inside the evaluation process

**Objective 1.2**

The office of teaching and learning will repose written, updated curriculum to be accessed by teachers on or off site.

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| Strategy 1.2.1 | Curriculum documents will be uploaded into the curriculum repository for teachers to have access from home and school.                                     |
| Strategy 1.2.2 | The curriculum handbook will be revised to include DESE's recommendation for the new standards and a better realistic time frame for the revision process. |

**Measurement:**

1. Each curricular department will have at least one unit of study uploaded within the repository for each quarter.
2. The DCC will receive regular updates on the process of creating new units of study

**GOAL 2: The Ozark R-VI School District will provide appropriate training for teachers and administrators to implement a guaranteed and viable curriculum. (District 2.B.1)**

**Objective 2.1**

The district will work with the Professional Learning Committee to ensure that teachers have adequate opportunities for learning how to best implement the written curriculum.

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| Strategy 2.1.1 | The Office of Teaching and Learning staff will provide training around unpacking the new standards and aligning/adjusting the taught curriculum. |
| Strategy 2.1.2 | The Office of Teaching and Learning staff will provide training around new curricular resources.   |

**Measurement:**

1. The BOE will be presented with documentation of how many hours of professional learning was provided for district staff.

**GOAL 3: The Ozark R-VI School District will maintain appropriate resources to accommodate the fidelity of the curriculum. (District 4.B.1)**

**Objective 3.1**

Resources will be vetted and approved according to the district curriculum handbook or on an as-needed basis.

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| Strategy 3.1.1 | The Office of Teaching and Learning staff will help vet and guide adopting new curricular resources that will help supplement the new curricular standards. |
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**Measurement:**

1. The District Curriculum Council will approve curricular resources, pass it on to the cabinet, and the BOE will then give the final approval.
